
LJ Grafted Wines

Since opening, this zero-waste practice has avoided 175,000 single-use glass wine bottles from production and disposal. Our wines are made in Napa by Alison Doran, one of the first and highly respected US woman winemakers.

WHITE WINES & ROSÉ

Chenin Blanc 2022, St. Helena, Napa Valley On the palate, pear, chamomile, and bees wax are balanced with a mouth-watering acidity and satisfying finish. Chenin Blanc is classically produced in South Africa and France's Loire Valley, and has the versatility to produce an array of styles including bone dry, sparkling, and sweet dessert. \$13/glass

Albariño 2023, Dunlap Vyd., Carneros, Napa Valley Grapes are sourced from the cool, maritime-climate area of Carneros in Southern Napa. The nose is filled with powerful aromas of white peach and jasmine. On the palate, find tropical notes of mango and pineapple with fresh acidity, and finishes crisp, saline, and dry. **\$14/glass**

Sauvignon Blanc 2022, **Select Vyds.**, **Napa Valley** Largely from the Stewart Vineyard, which is at sea level alongside the Napa River estuary. It's a late developing site with cool climate chemistry that results in Sauvignon Blanc with gooseberry and grapefruit flavors and crisp acidity. **\$13/glass**

Chardonnay 2022, Napa Valley Grown next to Hole 3 of Chardonnay Golf Club in Southern Napa Valley. Our winemaker, Alison, makes a restrained style with a touch of oak and minimal malolactic (creamy) influence. Bright acidity and finishes with pear, apple, and a hint of butterscotch. Won Gold at the 2024 SF Chronicle Wine Competition. \$15/glass

Rosé of Pinot Noir 2022, Petaluma Gap, Sonoma Coast Grapes are sourced from the cold, windy Petaluma Gap close to the Pacific Ocean along the Sonoma coast. This rosé has an alluring coral tint and aromas of orange blossom and candied cherries. On the palate, it's dry and crisp with layered flavors of strawberries and red apples. \$12/glass

DESSERT & SPARKLING WINES

Vin de Constance 2015, Klein Constantia, South Africa Famed and celebrated dessert wine from our former vineyard. Historically produced since 1685, this sweet wine exhibits notes of vanilla, apricot, and crème brûlée. \$15 per 1 oz Graham Beck Brut Rosé, South Africa Traditional method and bottle-fermented dry sparkling wine from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay made by our friends and former vineyard in Cape Town. \$50/bottle

RED WINES

Pinot Noir 2022, Senemar Vyd., Napa Valley Light, elegant, and fragrant. A classic expression from the cool climate of southern Napa. Abounds with a complex bouquet of red plum and dried cranberry with exotic floral undertones of red rose. Delightful and balanced from its silky first sip to its long finish. **\$18/glass**

Sangiovese 2022, Pauli Ranch, Mendocino The most planted grape variety of Italy with particular notoriety in Tuscany. This vintage is light-bodied and fruit forward with aromas of cranberry and pomegranate. Its approachable soft finish makes it a perfect wine to serve with a slight chill for the summer. **\$14/glass**

Syrah 2021, Feliz Creek Ranch, Hopland Mendocino Flavors of black cherry and pomegranate with alluring aromas of cracked black pepper and a faint hint of smoked meats on the finish. Round and inviting on the palate with moderate tannins. \$17/glass

Zinfandel 2021, Hoot Owl Vyd., Alexander Valley, Sonoma Grown in eastern Sonoma, this has rich and inviting aromas of cherry, blackberry, cacao, and complemented with subtle notes of orange rind. On the palate, this wine has smooth, rich tannins and a balanced profile. Won Gold at the 2024 SF Chronicle Wine Competition. \$15/glass

Bird Rock Blend #4 2021, Fore Family Vyds., Lake County A GSM blend, 36% Grenache brings fruit and juiciness, 26% Syrah delivers darker colors and enhanced spice notes, and 38% Mourvedre offers balanced tannin and structure. Grapes are grown in volcanic soils at high altitude and all work together for a complex and dense wine. **\$20/glass**

Petit Verdot 2021 Romeo Vyd., Calistoga, Napa Valley Usually a blending grape with other varietals to enhance color, tannin, and structure. This wine opens with aromas of plum, cedar, and hints of violet. It's a well-balanced, full-bodied wine and ends with a long, satisfying finish. **\$21/glass**

Cabernet Sauvignon 2021 Romeo Vyd., Calistoga, Napa Valley Another example of the world-class wines that Napa produces. A standout Napa wine with soft tannins and balanced with a long dry finish. With minimal oak usage, the plate has cassis and blackberry flavors while a spice component and hints of herbaceousness. \$24/glass
